#### 6. POHAS.CO.UK - Website

Work has started on revamping existing website, sample pages were shown to members for approval. Incurred costs for changing legal ownership from [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] was agreed. 'PB' to organise, develop and publish revamped site. Intention being that it attracts more members to site allowing more interaction, offers more information, and encourages other members to take an active part in club events, whilst hopefully help attract new members.

#### 7. Fisheries Update

'PR' commented that water levels at Whitegate was OK.

It was agreed that Work parties / 'Spring Cleans' would be discussed at next meeting once the light nights are here.

'PB' spoke with [REDACTED], they have not made any significant changes, especially stocking. It was agreed with members that this venue would not be used in 2006 calendar.

Although 'KW' was absent, he made a verbal comment that he was negotiating with other Angling Clubs with a view to us having access to their waters on a reciprocal arrangement as we now have with Whiston Anglers.

#### 10. AOB

'AR' supplied '2006 World Cup Draw' to be used as a fundraiser for club, which will generate money for club funds. 'FD' to speak with Maltings Landlord to get his approval to issue in pub.

Saturday June 10<sup>th</sup> has been agreed as the date for our annual fun day, once again being held at The Maltings. Likely to have a World Cup theme as it is the same day that England play Paraguay. Further discussions to take place at a future meeting.

Following 'FD' & 'KW' meeting regarding funding which took place in December 2005, we are awaiting for the next stage of the process to take place, 'FD' has been asked to contact after 10<sup>th</sup> March.

'PR' is looking to undertake a fisheries management course. He asked members if club would be happy to pay the admin charge of [REDACTED] which is for the candidate to become a member of the IFM (*Institute for Fishery Management*), this is a prerequisite before undertaking the course and is mandatory. 'PR' would personally fund the remainder of the course.

Paul's additional qualification would bring additional knowledge to our fishery management and again raise the club profile.

Members agreed that this would be good for the club, payment will be made when required.
