

Top Tips - Blundells Farm

Hi its Stripey here with my tips from Blundells Farm. I fished one line which was at 6-7 metres, my float was a 4x10 shotted with a bulk of 3 No 10s 4 inches from the hook which was a fox carp No 18s. I started the match at dead depth feeding small pellets and fishing maggot on the hook which i was reliably informed was the method. One and a half hours into the match with James and Neil bagging to my right & me with only one fish re-think was required. I decided to change my baits to chopped worm, casters, & corn being cupped in by pole cup. My hook bait then changed to small pieces of worm and i started to get bites nearly straight away. Sometimes if one thing doesn't work don't give up try something different. There is a lesson here for everyone!
