9. Fishery Update

Brownlee's Pool

Carp deaths currently at approximately 20 over the last 3 to 4 weeks following low oxygen levels. 'WT' want us to remove all Carp and add water features. [REDACTED] have promised us two artificial Islands free of charge. Leaf litter needs to be removed from pool and surrounding areas. 'WT' wish to revise new lease incorporating the above comments.

We have purchased a generator for £129 and are looking to purchase a submersible pump at a cost of approximately £100 which can then be used to artificially oxygenate either of our pools when necessary. The generator can be used also at work parties to supply electric equipment such as strimmers, chain saw etc.

Whitegate Pool

Work party on pool took place on Saturday 29th November to lay a footpath and plant 500 shoots to create a hedgerow. Thanks to **FD, AS, JG, KW, JAB, JPB & PB** for attending and working their n*ts off! Additional footpath work to be completed at a Spring 2009 work party.

Meeting took place on site today at 2pm with various departments of WBC to discuss dilapidated fencing adjacent to the embankment. Net result likely to be that fence will not be replaced as it was a temporary measure whilst tree's and bushes next to fence established themselves. '**PB**' has asked that WBC remove fencing and make good the area. '**FD**' suggested at the meeting that we plant further hedgerow to improve perimeter of pool area. This is to be done at a date yet to be decided. Revised lease for Whitegate has been delayed due to changes with WBC solicitors. Leak appears to have halted over recent weeks with water level remaining constant. WBC have had no further news from original groundworks contractor who at a site meeting on 22nd October promised to investigate possible leak.
