Message from British Waterways (Birmingham Office) regarding Earlswood (info received via e-mail on 30/06/08)

Its barbless hooks, no method feeder on the pole and two keep nets please. There are no restrictions on baits or other methods used.

The water levels are starting to drop now and for most you will be fishing off the lake bed and not the platforms. The water has a very shallow gradient. Can you please bring wellies or waders if just to peg your keep nets out.

You will be glad to hear its fishing very well. Pellet waggler or method feeder are the main stay with 8 or 10mm pellet or boilie on the hook. Please make sure you are geared up as the fish now average 9-11lb.
