9. Club Development

'PB' advised members that from 1<sup>st</sup> February 2011 POHAS have been awarded ClubMark status after almost 18 months work. We are to be presented with certificate, time, date and venue to be arranged by ADB. Thanks particularly go to 'FD', 'JAB' and to Darren Birch of ADB for all the work and support in us getting to this point.

'PB' completed SPC1 child protection course as back up to 'MR' who completed this course as our Child Welfare Officer. 'PB' also completed Equity course and 'JAB' to do Equity course, date to be agreed.

'FD' and 'PB' had meeting with school cluster group which covers Westbrook, Whittle Hall and Great Sankey North on 17<sup>th</sup> January. A presentation was made highlighting POHAS being able to offer coaching courses to schools as part of their extended services curriculum and subject to funding availability. Cluster group to discuss options with a view to coaching courses being run in the future.
