19/05/12 Hampton Springs – Long Island

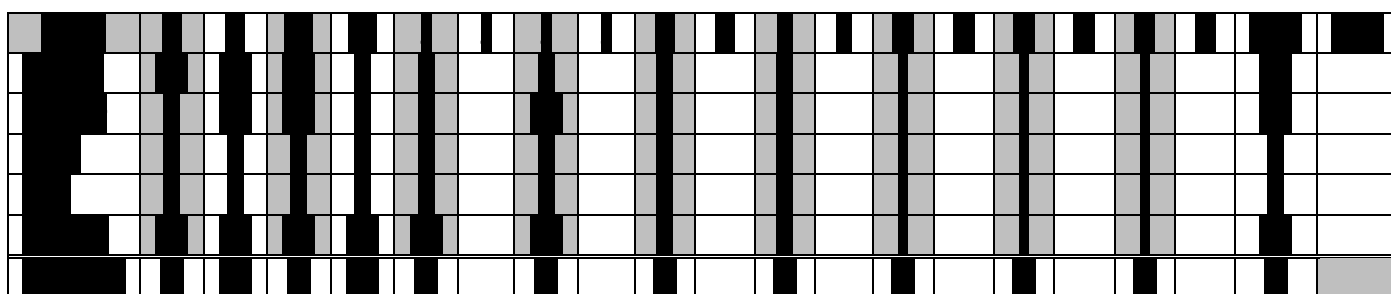
Rules available and passed around during tonight's meeting.
