

## PARTRIDGE LAKES FISHERY - RULES

- 1. Fishing Times Dawn to Dusk. No Night Fishing
- 2. Baitbands NO Boilies, Particles, Nuts, Bloodworm, Joker, Cat Food, Artificial Baits.
- 3. Barbless Hooks only.
- 4. NO Keep Nets (except during authorised matches)
- 5. Ground Bait in Moderation 1 LB (approx.) per peg.
- 6. No Braided Lines.
- 7. No. Dogs.
- 8. No Litter.

## **DIRECTIONS TO PARTRIDGE LAKES FROM THE M62**

Take Junction 9 off the M62.

Follow signs for Newton A49 to next roundabout. Take first exit, signposted Newton.

Take the first right turning at the Swan Pub then the next right opposite the church.

Carry on down this road for about 3 miles until you come to a sharp left hand bend. Glaziers Lane is on the crest of this bend. Turn right onto Glaziers Lane. Take the second right into a large car park, sign posted Partridge Lakes.

## <u>DIRECTIONS TO PARTRIDGE LAKES FROM EAST LANC.S</u>

At "Greyhound " roundabout take first exit to Warrington.

Pass Bents Garden Centre on the left and continue down this road apprx. two miles.

Go through Culcheth - past the Harrow pub.

You will go over a railway bridge as you come out of Culcheth. Look for signs for Taylor Business Park on the left. Opposite here take the right hand turn into Glaziers Lane.

Partridge Lakes is at the end of this lane.
