

WALTON LEA CREMATORIUM Location Map








Warrington Location

By Bus: Monday to Saturday - from Warrington or Runcorn take the Arriva x30 or Halton Transport 62 to the Walton Arms, then a five minute walk. Sundays - from Warrington or Runcorn take the Halton Transport C31 to The Walton Arms. Telephone 01925 444250 for details of running times.



DIRECTIONS TO WALTON LEA CREMATORIUM

From the M6 Junction 22 - Croft Interchange

Leave the motorway at Junction 22. Follow signs to Warrington on the A49. The A49 will take you all the way to Bridgefoot (see below).

From the M6 Junction 21 - Woolston Interchange

Leave the motorway at Junction 21. Follow signs to Warrington on the A57. After passing Warrington Cemetery on your left, ° Of a mile ahead the road forks left and right. Take the left fork so that a large Sainsbury's supermarket is on your right, you will reach a large traffic island which, bearing left will take you onto Mersey Street and Bridgefoot traffic island.

From Warrington Bridgefoot

Travelling south down Mersey Street (A49) as you near the lights, move into right hand lane. At the lights to two lanes become four and you need to take the second from the right marked A5060 on the road. This lane will take you across the lights and over the bridge, taking care to stay in right hand lane. At the bottom of the bridge there are more lights and your lane will become two lanes, one going round the island back into Warrington and the other becoming the A56, signposted for the M56 and Walton, which you must follow. This will bring you onto Chester Road (A56) which will take you over a swing bridge, sharp right hand bend and onto the dual carriageway. After a short distance you will see a sign for the crematorium and a shallow lane on the left to pull into.

Travelling West from M6 Junction 20 - Lymm Interchange

Take the road signposted A50 to Warrington. At the first set of lights, turn left onto the A56 Chester Road which will take you through the centre of Stockton Heath. Go across the main traffic lights and follow the A56 to the end of the road where you will turn left onto the dual carriageway. The crematorium is signposted and there is a shallow lane on the left to pull into.

Travelling North from M56 Junction 11 - Daresbury Interchange

Leave the motorway at Junction 11 and follow the signs for Warrington and Daresbury. This road is the A56 and will take you directly to Walton Lea. After crossing the distinctive "toast rack" bridge, bear right at the traffic lights, into the feeder lane and turn right into Old Chester Road, almost immediately, turn right again into Walton Lea Road and this will take you to the crematorium.

Travelling North on the A49 through Stockton Heath

At the main traffic lights in the centre of Stockton Heath, turn left onto the A56 Chester Road. Follow this road to the end and turn left onto the beginning of the dual carriageway. After a short distance, the crematorium will be signposted and there is a feed lane to pull into near the entrance.
